

Cardboard Box Car Rules

- Only regular cardboard, duct tape, masking tape, scotch tape and paint may be used to construct the cardboard sleds.
- No industrial pressed cardboard, NO PLASTICS OR METAL OF ANY KIND. (i.e. clock boxes, industrial shipment boxes)
- Any type of paint may be used to decorate boxes.
- Box Sleds must have a front, rear, bottom, and two sides.
- No wood, glue, industrial adhesives, staples, ropes, twine, or wire will be permitted on box sled.
- Sleds MUST NOT exceed 6 feet in length and 4 feet in width.

Race Rules:

- No more than 6 participants per box.
- ALL participants must wear helmets (bike helmets permissible).
- Any race official who deems a box to be unsafe or not to specifications has the authority to disqualify box team in question.
- All boxes, parts and participants have to cross the finish line!
- Boxes will race in heats of 3 or 4.
- No intentional contact or bumping while racing.
